

Traitement tocolytique prénatal et durée d'allaitement

Etude sur le lien entre la prise de traitement tocolytique et la durée de l'allaitement ou l'hypogalactie.

Résumé de l'auteur :

"Background: To date there are no clinical studies analyzing potential effects of tocolytics on breastfeeding duration in humans.

Objectives: The purpose of this study was to evaluate the association between beta 2 agonists prescribed for tocolysis during pregnancy and breastfeeding duration.

Results: There was a statistically significant difference between breastfeeding duration of mothers who were on tocolytics during pregnancy versus those who were not prescribed tocolytics (9.5 ± 5.7 months versus 4.5 ± 2.1 months) p
